Fact Sheet

NHSC Loan Repayment Program:

This program allows healthcare providers in primary medical care, dental health, or mental health disciplines to apply for up to \$50,000 in student loan repayment in exchange for at least two years of service at an NHSC approved site. Applicants may apply to continue their contract after the initial term, one year at a time, until their student loans are completely paid off. Continuation awards are made based on available funds and at the Government's discretion. The following provider types are eligible to apply for this program:

Students to Service Loan Repayment Program:

This program allows medical and dental students in their final year of school to apply for up to \$120,000 of student loan repayment in exchange for three years of service providing primary healthcare at an NHSC approved site, in an area of greatest need. Applicants may apply to continue their contract, one year at a time, until their student loans are paid off. Continuation awards are made based on available funds and at the Government's discretion. This program is only available to MD, DO, DDS, and DMD.

NHSC Scholarship Program:

This program provides scholarships, including tuition, approved educational costs, and a living stipend in return for at least two years of service at an NHSC approved site. It is available to students accepted to or enrolled in an accredited program in one of the following disciplines:

- Medicine
- Dentistry
- NP
- CNM
- PA
