# National Health Service Corps Eligible Sites

## Fact Sheet

### Site Requirements:

In order to become eligible to hire providers wishing to apply for NHSC programs, sites must meet the following requirements:

- Submit an application to be reviewed by the Utah PCO and HRSA
- Be located in a federally designated HPSA (priority given to sites with a HPSA score of 14 or above)
- Provide primary medical, dental, and/or mental/behavioral health services
- Provide services regardless of ability to pay
- Offer a sliding fee scale
- Accept Medicare, Medicaid, and CHIP, where applicable
