

**R434. Health, Family Health and Preparedness, Primary Care and Rural Health.**

**R434-50. Assistance for People with Bleeding Disorders.**

**R434-50-1. Authority and Purpose.**

This rule is required by and implements Section 26-47-103.

**R434-50-2. Definitions.**

The terms in this rule are defined in Subsection 26-47-103 (1). In addition, "Department" means the Utah Department of Health.

**R434-50-3. Grant Application.**

An applicant applying for a grant under this rule shall submit an application as directed in the grant application guidance issued by the Department.

**R434-50-4. Criteria for Awarding Grants.**

The Department shall consider:

- (1) the extent to which the applicant:
  - (a) demonstrates that it will provide assistance to the greatest number of persons with bleeding disorders residing across the state;
  - (b) utilizes other sources of funding, including private funding, to provide bleeding disorder services; and
  - (c) provides:
    - (i) information that meets the requirements established in Subsection 26-47-103(3);
    - (ii) a description of the individuals to be served by the grant;
    - (iii) the estimated number of individuals to be served with the grant award; and
    - (iv) the results of an assessment of need demonstrating the need for the bleeding disorder services that the grantee proposes to provide;
- (2) the cost to the person with a bleeding disorder for the bleeding disorder services;
- (3) the degree to which the applicant meets the requirements of the statute; and
- (4) the degree to which the application is feasible, clearly described, and ready to be implemented.

**R434-50-5. Qualified Service Recipients.**

(1) As required by Subsection 26-47-103 (1)(b)(iii)(D), the Department establishes that to meet the definition of a person with a bleeding disorder, the individual's premiums for private health insurance coverage, or cost sharing under private coverage, must be at or greater than 7.5% of the individual's adjusted gross income.

(2) The grantee must assure that each individual to whom it provides service under a grant awarded under this rule meets the requirements of this rule and Subsection 26-47-103 (1)(b).
